She died at Swallowfield Park near Reading – a property of The Country Gentlemen's Association which was divided up into apartments, but with common dining and other facilities. I was working and living not too far away at the time – Camberley – and used to visit them fairly regularly. I believe she arranged her own departure, as she was suffering from cancer for some time before her death, which I believe was a result of her work in radiology in the 20s and 30s. Douglas outlived her for a couple of years.
