**Of Tunbridge Wells, in the County of Kent being of sound mind do dispose of my worldly substance in manner following and by those present do constitute and appoint my worthy friend and ...man Richard Loa Esquire and Alderman of London and my son in law Richard Matthew Of Oxford Street in the County of Middlesex Executors of this my last will and Testament And first, I will and direct that my body be Buried in a devout and frugal manner at the Direction of my said executors and that all my Just debts and funeral expenses be paid and Satisfied I also will and direct that all my property Both real and personal be realized as soon as Convenient after my decease and a just estimate Made of whatever property I shall be possessed of and at the discretion of my Executors placed out to the best advantage for the use and benefit of my children and the Interest appropriated to the use of my daughter Caroline STRANGE and son James STRANGE till James shall attain the age of twenty one years ##### the ##### of the property then remaining shall be divided equally among all my children share and share alike namely Ann Constant Matthew Thomas STRANGE William STRANGE Edward STRANGE Elizabeth Maids Mary Prior Jane Young Sarah STRANGE Sophia STRANGE Caroline STRANGE and James STRANGE I also will And direct that my executors to this my last will And Testament shall not be answerable for Mismanagement or Misconduct of either of the Others but only accountable of either of the Others but only accountable for what moneys they Receive or pay themselves for their own expenses Transactions and I also direct that each of my Executors do have a Mourning Ring of two guineas value and I do hereby renounce all former Wills by me made and declare this my last Will and Testament and written on one sheet of paper in my own handwriting and to which I have set my seal this Eighteenth Day of September the year of our Lord 1806 Edward STRANGE (D.D.) Signed, sealed and published and declared by the said Edward STRANGE as and for his last will and Testament in the presence of us.**
